JACKSON (December 19, 2014) – The Jackson Area Transportation Authority (JATA), Jackson County Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition (JCSAPC), Jackson Citizen Patriot, Rave Associates, Jackson Police and JTV will be sponsoring the New Year's Eve shuttle on December 31, 2014. This year marks the 30th anniversary of the shuttle.

The New Year's Eve shuttle will be available between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

The program is intended to provide a free ride home for people who may have had too much to drink while celebrating the coming New Year. This service is being offered to prevent drinking and driving.

JATA offers the following tips to anyone who plans to use the shuttle:

- Call 517-788-8410 for reservations (starting at 11:00 p.m. December 31st)
- It is recommended (but not required) that customers call at least 45 minutes in advance for a reservation
- Do not call the shuttle to take you to another bar or party; only call the shuttle for a ride home
