1. Mix pills and liquids with cat litter or used coffee grounds, and warm water to make an undesirable solution.
2. Place mixture in a container, such as a sealed plastic bag, and throw container in your household trash.
3. Before throwing out your empty pill bottle, remember to scratch out all information on the label.
